## Bug fixes

### Deep copy of tests not allowing copy to other discipline

#### Problem

We fixed an issue in Academy where performing a Deep Copy of a test or survey and selecting a different discipline during the copy process did not take effect — the copied content would retain the original discipline instead of the newly selected one. The root cause was a hidden module ID field on the page that overrode the user's discipline selection during the copy operation.

#### Fix

The system now correctly exposes the module selector so that the copied test or survey is placed into the module belonging to the selected discipline, with all associated items and stimuli content copied successfully.

### When documentUrls are not included in the report columns, the inactive links are still included in 'Catalogue Item Learning Asset Link' report

#### Problem

Expected behaviour for 'Catalogue Item Learning Asset Link' report only happened when the 'Document URLs' column was included. When not included inactive links were still in report.

#### Fix

We have implemented a fix to correctly remove previously linked assets when running the customisable report using the Catalogue Item Learning Asset Link field, even when 'Document URLs' column is excluded. The report now only shows currently linked assets.

## Improvements

### Implement new CommWeb 2.0 Payment Gateway Integration

We have introduced a new CommWeb 2.0 (MPGS) payment gateway integration in Academy. Administrators can now configure a CommWeb 2.0 gateway in Payment Settings by providing their Merchant ID, API Password, Gateway Base URL, API Version, and Merchant Display Name, then assign it to catalogue items as a payment method.

When a learner enrolls in a paid catalogue item and selects CommWeb 2.0, they are securely redirected to CommBank's hosted payment page where they enter their card details and complete any required 3-D Secure verification.

On successful payment, the learner is returned to Academy and presented with an enrolment confirmation and receipt — enrolment is only created after server-side payment verification with CommBank. Declined payments are handled entirely on CommBank's page where the learner can retry, and cancelling returns the learner to the enrolment wizard without any charge or enrolment being created. Card details are never entered in Academy.

## **Add Warning to Local Academy B2C Authentication Settings When Global Authentication B2C Settings are not configured**

Administrators will now see a clear warning on the local tenant Authentication settings page if the required global Azure AD B2C configuration is incomplete, helping to identify and resolve setup issues before configuring authentication on a local tenant.
