The Janison Insights Release **2024.04.02** includes bug fixes and improvements.

Bug fixes

Delivery

- Issues were discovered when clients attempted to Add Extra Time or Allow Candidates Entry on tests where the Enable Heartbeat setting was turned off. All tests should have a heartbeat, so this setting is now being deprecated. (JIRA INS-7770, HELPDESK 114383)
- A bug in calculating remaining time that was preventing the addition of time when a student remained on the same question screen for an extended duration has been resolved. (JIRA INS-7971)

New Features & Improvements

User Management

- The UI for `assessmentevents/event/details/[eventid]` when adding Groups in the Candidate Enrolments > Add Enrolments sub-section has been updated. Now a progress bar will show how far through the process is. This will be true if the enrolments are processed through the Web view or as a Bulk Action. This will prevent UI timeouts while processing large numbers of enrolments and will provide more useful information to the user. (JIRA INS-7759)
- Marker visibility hierarchy previously only displayed Markers in a project if they were lower in the hierarchy than the logged in user, but Senior Markers do need to see each other to know if they are already on a Marking project or not, so the visibility rules have changed so that Senior Markers in a project can now also see other markers of the same rank in their projects as well. (JIRA INS-6222)

Delivery

- Support for `input()` code was added to the IDE question type. A pop-up will show asking the student to give a value for each instance of `input()`. Inputs will persist across runs of the response. If there are no instances of `input()` then no pop-up will show and the code will run as per current behaviour. (JIRA INS-7899)
