Release Notes

The Janison Insights Release **2024.11.01** includes bug fixes and improvements.

Bug fixes

Authoring

- Authoring allowed decimal places for Composite Interaction Weights, but Marking only expected integers. New validation has been added to Authoring to prevent the saving of decimal values. (JIRA INS-8270)
- Gap Match Interaction questions were not respecting the "Minimum Gap Display Width" field, but this has now been fixed. (JIRA INS-7425, HELPDESK 106973)

Delivery

- The issue preventing the Redirect to URL on logout from functioning correctly during sequential package tests with a single login has been resolved. Now, when a student logs out after taking a sequential package test, they will be redirected to the specified redirect URL. (JIRA INS-8400)
- An issue with the "Redirect URL on Logout" feature has been identified and fixed. Previously, students taking sequential assessment packages with automatic transitions to the next test were redirected to a specified URL upon test submission, preventing access to their next test. This fix ensures a smooth transition between tests, allowing students to continue without encountering a login or external page. (JIRA INS-8511)
- An issue causing the test player to get stuck on "Checking for Updates" has been identified and resolved. Previously, the test player would wait indefinitely due to a network request timing out, resulting in a spinning loading circle and preventing further use. This occurred because the network request failed to reach the server and lacked a timeout configuration. A default timeout of one minute has been added, ensuring the test player no longer waits indefinitely for a server response. After the timeout, the test player will display an error banner with

Reporting

- An issue affecting the end-of-test results summary page in the Test Player has been found and resolved. Previously, candidates were seeing a score of 0/0 instead of the correct mark for certain categories. Our investigation revealed that this was due to a referencing error, where the categories were not being matched correctly. With this fix, students will now receive an accurate and detailed test results summary and breakdown upon completing their tests. This update ensures that all scores are correctly displayed, providing a clearer and more reliable assessment of performance. (JIRA INS-8745, HELPDESK 134494)

New Features & Improvements

Delivery

- An enhancement has been made to the test sessions administration page and test attempt details for offline delivered test attempts. Previously, when tests were delivered offline and later reconciled, the Device Name would appear as "Unavailable." With this update, the Device Name will now be accurately populated, regardless of whether the test was delivered online, offline, or through resilient delivery modes. This improvement ensures that devices used for each test attempt are correctly identified, enhancing the accuracy and reliability of device tracking. (JIRA INS-8657)
- Introducing a new feature that simplifies the process for Test Administrators to start all late-entry students in a session. Previously, administrators had to navigate to the Waiting Entry tab, select the checkbox at the top left, and then click Allow Start. Now, with the new "Start All" button, administrators can start all late-entry students sitting on Wait to Begin with a single click. This change will allow for all attempts, regardless of amount, to be started in a single click. This feature is available from both the All and Waiting Entry tabs, streamlining the workflow, saving time, and reducing the steps needed to start late-entry students. This update is designed to enhance experience and efficiency. (JIRA INS-8694)
- New keyboard shortcuts have been introduced to significantly enhance the device renaming process, allowing users to rename devices with greater speed and efficiency. These shortcuts - Alt + Q to toggle edit mode, Alt +

Enter to save the name edit, and Escape to cancel the edit - simplify the workflow. When a device is locked, users are prompted to unlock it before entering edit mode, ensuring security while maintaining convenience. Once the edit is saved or cancelled, the device re-locks automatically. If the device is already unlocked, it seamlessly enters edit mode and remains unlocked after the edit. These improvements not only make the renaming process more intuitive but also boost overall productivity by reducing the time and effort required for device management. (JIRA INS-8535)

- Incident Reports can now be created specifically for Personal Needs and Preferences. This new report type ensures accurate reporting of incidents related to individual requirements. Upon selection, the details box is pre-populated with templated text, which can be customized. This enhancement addresses the need for precise documentation of personal needs and preferences issues. (JIRA INS-8714).
- The back button feature for incident reports has been enhanced to improve navigation. Now, when viewing a list of incident reports linked to a session code, organisation unit, or assessment event, the back button will return users to the specific list they were referred from. Previously, the back button would always return users to the organisation unit-linked incident reports list. This improvement ensures a more intuitive and efficient user experience. (JIRA INS-8693)

Platform

- A new endpoint has been added to Styles and Images to allow the B2C login page to pull styling information to itself. This will mean the B2C login pages will now be able to look like the native Insights login pages for your tenant. (JIRA INS-8614)

Reporting

- A valuable new feature has been added to the Test Attempt PNP custom reports. Test administrators can now easily identify users who have been allocated a PNP code. This enhancement improves the ability to manage and track test accommodations efficiently. (JIRA INS-8704)
