# Release Notes

The Janison Insights Release **2025.02.02** includes bug fixes and improvements.

## Bug fixes

### People

- We have resolved an issue that caused the candidate details page to fail to load when a candidate's profile included the custom attribute of type "Date". Users can now access the page without errors, ensuring a smooth and consistent viewing experience for all candidate details. (JIRA: INS-9364)
- Improved data consistency by ensuring the 'GET/user' and 'GET/user/{userId}' APIs return the same user details. Previously, these APIs provided different data for the same user, causing inconsistencies. This enhancement ensures uniform and reliable user information across services. (JIRA: INS-9371)

### Delivery

- We have resolved an issue where candidates who switched devices during a test experienced data loss, as their previously answered questions were not transferred to the new device. With this update, all answered question data is now securely retained and transferred, allowing candidates to continue their tests seamlessly from a new device without any omissions. (JIRA: INS-9355)
- During testing, we identified an issue where candidates encountered a white screen when re-entering a reopened test attempt. This occurred after an invigilator reopened the attempt. With this fix, candidates can now seamlessly re-enter and complete their test without any interruptions. (JIRA: INS-9380)
- We have fixed an issue that prevented invigilators from postponing a test after a candidate had started. With this fix, invigilators can now pause or postpone tests during an ongoing exam, ensuring better management of interruptions and a smoother testing experience. (JIRA: INS-9370)

- We have updated the org unit (school) filter on the Test Attempts page to properly display all organisation unit options in the dropdown. Thus, allowing users to apply and accurately filter test attempts based on their selected criteria. (JIRA: INS-8761)
- We have fixed an issue where the Device Name in the Test Session Administration dashboard reverted to the original device name instead of displaying the updated name. This issue occurs when a student is logged in using QR code with OTC, making it difficult for invigilators to track student devices accurately. With this fix, the student updated Device Name on the Test Player is correctly displayed on the Test session page. (JIRA: INS-9518)
