Release Notes

The Janison Insights Release **2025.06.01** includes bug fixes and improvements.

Bug fixes

Authoring

- We fixed an issue where the Test Preview mode for branching tests would freeze after completing the second section, preventing users from progressing through the full test. With this fix, the preview functionality now works as expected, allowing the full test to be completed. (JIRA: INS-9974)
- We fixed a bug where Branching with Parallel Paths, was not functioning correctly on Insights Core. The necessary settings and tools have now been updated to fully support ADS branching logic and calculations, ensuring consistent behaviour across both authoring and playback. (JIRA: INS-9988)

Delivery

- We have resolved an issue on the Test Session Admin screen where the columns were not sorting correctly. Specifically, the "Progress" column did not sort in a meaningful order, making it difficult for teachers to identify students falling behind during a test session. This fix ensures that all sortable columns, including "Progress", now behave as expected when clicked. (JIRA: INS-9321)
- We fixed a bug where the total number of questions displayed on Insights for the same test did not match and changed dynamically as new test sections were reached. With this fix, both SQL and NoSQL systems now consistently show the correct total number of questions throughout the test session. (JIRA: INS-9924)
- There was an issue where some student attempts were being prematurely submitted while the student was still answering questions, causing them to be locked out of the test. This occurred sporadically during NoSQL, session-less, self-registered test deliveries. We have implemented a code fix that ensures more comprehensive activity logging and ensures accurate tracking of attempt status. (JIRA: INS-9976)

Marking

- Reviewing Monitoring Scripts that were imported to a marking Project was giving an "Access Denied" error. A further issue was found that Composite Items in Monitoring Scripts would not correctly show their interactions. Both these issues are now resolved (JIRA: INS-8683)

Reporting

- We have removed the Reference Mean and Reference Deviation fields from the Test Components Results Determination section and dropped the related columns from the database, as these are no longer required for OUP reporting. Associated string resources referencing these fields have also been removed. (JIRA: INS-9849)

Platform

- Logos were not being shown correctly in the B2C login pages. This has now been resolved. (JIRA: INS-9109)

New Features & Improvements

Authoring

- We have added unique icons for newly introduced test types on the "Tests & Surveys" page in Insights. Each test type - Branching with Parallel Paths, CAT, and Branching CAT, now displays a distinct icon for clearer visual identification. (JIRA: INS-9983)

Delivery

- We have improved the navigation experience for candidates accessing public tests. Candidates are now taken directly to the first question of the test via a new lightweight entry page, bypassing the One Time Code screen. This update reduces UI delays and simplifies the flow. The new page includes a loading spinner and displays error messages using the same banner style as the original One Time Code page. Please contact your Janison Account Manager for more details. - A new status was added to the Test Attempt table to track proctored onboarding status. (JIRA: INS-9977)

Reporting

- We have improved timezone handling in assessment program scheduling. With this update, the tenant timezone is now stored with scheduling data to ensure accurate date/time interpretation. Users are notified if the timezone has changed since the last save, and displayed times remain consistent across device and tenant timezone changes. (JIRA: INS-10028)
