Release Notes

The Janison Insights Release **2025.07.01** includes bug fixes and improvements.

Bug fixes

Marking

- We have fixed a bug where the keyword answer evaluation ignored all whitespaces by default, causing incorrect matches (e.g. "to tally" being accepted as "totally"). This occurred because the 'Ignore All WhiteSpace' setting was always enabled with no UI control. A new option has been added to the UI, allowing users to configure the 'Remove All Whitespace' setting when creating keyword questions. (JIRA: INS-9997, INS-8871)

Delivery

- We have fixed an issue where updates to processing schedule days were not saved when editing an existing assessment program. Changes to selected days now persist correctly after saving. Timeslots and start/end dates are also saved as expected, and Monday is set by default when all days are cleared. (JIRA: INS-10121)
- We have fixed an issue, when changing a user's local machine time or timezone incorrectly altered the tenant's scheduled time slots. With this fix, time slots are consistently based on the tenant timezone and remain unchanged regardless of the user's local date, time, or daylight savings settings. (JIRA: INS-10124)

Marking

- We have resolved an issue where some participants' assignment feedback pages failed to display the Scheme Component breakdown, showing only the overall score instead. The issue was not tied to specific test attempts, result outcomes, or assessment events. The fix ensures that when marking

scheme components are defined and used, all participants now consistently see the detailed feedback breakdown. (JIRA: INS-10080)

- We have fixed an issue preventing some markers from submitting Writing and Speaking attempts. This error previously blocked their progress to the next enrolment script, prevented Chief markers from viewing affected enrolments, and student result releases. With this fix, markers can now successfully submit marks, ensuring a smooth workflow and timely result release. (JIRA: INS-10120)

New Features & Improvements

ProctorTrack

- We have introduced a new setting to support clients who require students to complete Onboarding before participating in proctored main events. A new "Mandatory Onboarding Requirement" checkbox option is now available under Proctoring Integration Settings. When enabled, this setting ensures that only students with an Approved Onboarding profile can access Proctored Events labelled "Main Event". It does not affect access to events labelled "Onboarding Event". (JIRA: INS-10062)
- Performance improvements were made to our new Proctoring Integration Daemon. Now syncs to the external Proctoring system to provision user tests are significantly more efficient. (JIRA: INS-10051)
