Release Notes

The Janison Insights Release **2025.07.02** includes bug fixes and improvements.

Bug fixes

Delivery

- We have fixed an issue where using Bulk Cancel on assessment attempts did not update the enrolment status as expected. Now, when all open attempts are cancelled in bulk, the enrolment status will correctly transition to reflect completion, ensuring that the workflow and reporting remain accurate.

(JIRA: INS-10174)

Marking

- We have fixed an issue where cancelled or abandoned test attempts were incorrectly shown as 'Marking' in reports. With this fix, these attempts display the correct status, preventing unnecessary marking and ensuring more accurate reporting data. (JIRA: INS-10156)

New Features & Improvements

Authoring

- A new feature has been added allowing users to set a distinct "Display Name for Reporting" for each module within Insights. This allows detailed module names for internal use while displaying simplified, clearer names in reports. For instance, a module named "Y6 English" in Insights can appear as just "English" in the Reporting app, helping users easily identify and differentiate modules in reports. (JIRA: INS-10136)

Reporting

- We have improved how time slot scheduling is handled within Assessment Program scheduling. Previously, time slots were sent as a full date and time, but with this enhancement, the system will send time slot information as just hour and minute values. (JIRA: INS-10157)
- We have improved Assessment Programs to give users more flexibility. With this enhancement, users can pause an Assessment Program even if there are validation issues. This allows users to make necessary adjustments without being blocked. (JIRA: INS-10143)

Settings

- We have simplified the Test Authoring page by removing the “Branching test” and “Enable test blueprints” options from the settings. Authors will now only see relevant test type options, making the test creation process clearer and more streamlined. (JIRA: INS-9547)

Proctoring

- We have introduced a new tenant setting, “Onboarding Valid for:” [x] days, allowing admins to define how long a student’s onboarding profile remains valid. This value is configurable between 2 and 999 days and is now central to determining a student’s eligibility for proctored exams. If the onboarding profile is expired, a student cannot take a proctored exam if Onboarding is mandatory on the tenant. (JIRA: INS-10097)
- Proctored Event types are now streamlined to support only two specific formats: Onboarding Events and Main Events. This update ensures clarity and consistency in event classification, helping admins maintain clean configurations while aligning with exam requirements. By narrowing the event types, we reduce complexity and reinforce the core structure of proctored assessment workflows. (JIRA: INS-10094)
