Release Notes

The Janison Insights Release **2026.01.01** includes bug fixes and improvements.

Bug fixes

Authoring

- We have resolved an issue where creating a new test, section, or item in Firefox failed because the Module dropdown was disabled. With this update, authors using Firefox can again select a Module from the dropdown and create new content without interruption. (JIRA: INS-10475)

Delivery

- We have resolved an issue that caused rescheduled Speaking or Writing test attempts to be missing an identifier. With this update, both original and rescheduled attempts now correctly display their identifiers, ensuring consistency and improving the marking process. (JIRA: INS-10325)
- We have resolved an issue where some submitted exams were not available for marking because the test attempt status was updated to “Completed” but the enrolment status remained “Not attempted.” With this update, all submitted exams now correctly transition to a “Pending marking” state and are available to markers without manual intervention, even when automarking processes are under load. (JIRA: INS-10721)
- We have fixed an issue when some imported tests caused questions in instruction sections to be given non-zero weight. The import process has been improved so that any incorrectly weighted instruction-section questions are now set to a weight of 0 during import, preventing these invalid weights from being reintroduced. This fix ensures Module Scaling uploads run cleanly and helps OUP maintain accurate scoring setup without needing manual data correction. (INS-10878)

Marking

- We have fixed an issue w importing an archived script for use with standardisation is not visible after upload. Users can now upload an archived script to use as the reference script for use in marking. (INS-10846)

New Features & Improvements

Delivery

- We have made an improvement when transitioning an Assessment Program from Draft to “Data Flow Enabled”, the system now validates all included items to ensure they meet reporting dimension requirements. Any question with a non-zero weight that is missing required custom attributes will block the transition, and a clear modal will be shown listing the affected items and missing attributes, along with guidance on how to resolve them. This enhancement helps maintain accurate and reliable reporting data before enabling data flows. (INS-10744)
- We have improved the bulk print experience for answer sheets so that when a print request cannot be processed, the loading spinner is cleared and a warning icon appears beside the affected rows. Hovering over this icon now shows a clear error message from the backend, helping users quickly understand why printing is unavailable and adjust their selection without getting stuck on a disabled print button or an indefinitely loading screen. We also refined the automatic print dialog behaviour so it only appears in the appropriate contexts and ensured the modal closes reliably once printing starts. (JIRA: INS-10875)
