Release Notes

The Janison Insights Release **2026.02.02** includes bug fixes and improvements.

Bug fixes

People

- We have fixed the Manage Enrolment Data grid so that only real changes compared to the original data are treated as unsaved changes. With this update, if a user modifies a group's language and then manually reverts it back to the original value, the Clear changes and Update buttons now correctly disable and the unsaved changes prompt no longer appears when switching years, reducing confusion and preventing unnecessary warnings. (JIRA: INS-11062)

Delivery

- We have tightened the rules for postponed students so they can no longer bypass the "Wait to begin" screen by joining a new test session that has not started. A postponed student can now start immediately only when the session is open (sessionless delivery) or when the session allows unrestricted entry, is in Started/Paused status, and the assessment event allows re-entry without requiring unlock; otherwise, they will remain on the waiting screen until the session starts. (JIRA: INS-10187)
- We have fixed an issue where the "Language" filter on the Event Enrolment screen showed all configured languages, including those marked as inactive for a tenant. The dropdown now only lists active languages from Settings → Languages when multilingual support is enabled, and remains empty when multilingual support is disabled, so administrators can no longer filter enrolments using inactive or unsupported languages. (JIRA: INS-11068)
- We have fixed the Manage Enrolment Data grid so that only real changes compared to the original data are treated as unsaved changes. With this update, if a user modifies a group's language and then manually

- We have fixed an issue with the Hybrid Printable Answer Sheet where templates would fail to render answer options when page breaks were configured on question sections in mixed-delivery tests, due to incompatible Angular directives on the same element. With this update, printable answer sheets now generate correctly from Manage test attempts for assessment events that use page breaks, so coordinators can reliably produce scan-ready answer sheets without console errors or missing content. (JIRA: INS-11162)
- We have fixed an issue where the Year Level dropdown on the Manage Enrolment Data screen did not honour the custom Year order configured under Settings → Years. The dropdown now uses the configured display sequence (including any drag-and-drop reordering), and updates automatically when the Year order is changed, so administrators see a consistent K-13 (or tenant-specific) sequence across enrolment management workflows. (JIRA: INS-11074)

Settings

- We have fixed the Years settings so that Year values are now validated as alphanumeric only, limited to 255 characters, with clear messages when invalid or too-long values are entered, preventing bad data from being saved. We also fixed the Recent activities section so that actions like creating, editing, enabling/disabling, and reordering Years are now logged with the user and timestamp, giving administrators clear visibility of changes. In addition, we fixed how disabled Years behave so that any user already assigned to a disabled Year still shows that Year when edited, while ensuring disabled Years cannot be selected for new assignments. (JIRA: INS-11035)

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Improvements

Delivery

- We have improved how students are enrolled into Assessment Events when using user-based filters. Previously, enrolments could ignore selected attributes and show inactive or disabled options, making it hard to target the right candidates. With this update, Test Admins can enable advanced enrolment filtering, choose which user attributes (such as Year, Language) are available, and rely on cleaned-up dropdowns so that only candidates who are in the selected group or group type and match all chosen attributes are enrolled. (JIRA: INS-10840)
- We have added an “Instructions to Candidates” section to the Hybrid Printable Answer Sheet template so candidates know how to complete their answer sheets correctly. The first page now includes configurable, translatable instructions covering where to find the questions, how to write answers, how to fill in multiple-choice responses, and how to avoid marking the QR codes. (JIRA: INS-11089)
- We have improved the Hybrid Answer Sheet print template so that the student’s name now appears between the two QR codes on every page of the answer sheet, instead of only on the first page. The name is automatically repeated across all pages in both print preview and the final printed/PDF output, helping test administrators and markers quickly match loose pages back to the correct student if sheets become separated. To keep the layout clear and avoid impacting QR code readability, very long names are limited to 30 characters with an ellipsis applied when they exceed this length, ensuring the header remains readable and the QR codes continue to generate and scan as before. Platform

- We improved Insights’ security handling for rich text and imports by hardening XSS protection in key authoring areas. The HTML sanitiser now strips Angular expression execution blocks and removes on error attributes from any tag so that malicious scripts can no longer run when authors create or edit questions,

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stimuli, or resources, even if unsafe content is pasted into the editor. We also tightened the Excel importer so that potentially dangerous markup, such as crafted anchor tags, is treated as harmless literal text instead of executable content, helping protect users while still allowing item authors to work with the content they need. New Features

Authoring – Curriculum Linkage

Curriculum Links

We've introduced the ability to link assessment items to curriculum frameworks, giving you greater control over how your assessments align with educational standards. (Jira INS-10503)

What's new:

- Curriculum Import — Administrators can now import curriculum hierarchies via spreadsheet, supporting multiple levels of depth (e.g., Domain > Subdomain) with flexible naming conventions to suit your organisation's terminology.
- Item-Level Curriculum Mapping — When editing items, a new "Curricula" section lets you map each item to a specific curriculum element using cascading dropdowns with search/filter support. Multiple curriculum mappings can be added per item.
