# Release Notes

The Janison Insights Release **2026.06.02** includes bug fixes and improvements.

## Bug fixes

### People

- We fixed an issue in the Student Import workflow where the Bulk Operation Summary screen failed to display the statistical import report after a student import completed successfully. The import completion email was being sent correctly, but the message payload was not being persisted back to the database record. The system now correctly saves the message payload linkage after the completion email is generated, allowing both the progress viewer and the Bulk Operation Summary details page to display the full import results summary as expected. (JIRA: INS-11944)

### Authoring

- We fixed an inconsistency in the authoring experience where mandatory fields such as Curriculum (Discipline) and Domain (Module) did not consistently display validation error messages, red borders, or mandatory field indicators when saving pages without required values. The issue affected multiple authoring pages including Tests, Test Sections, Resources, Stimuli, Items, and Test Components. Authoring pages now display consistent validation feedback — including a red border, error message, and mandatory field indicator across all required fields when a save is attempted without completing them. (JIRA: INS-11222)



## Delivery

- We fixed an issue where students were experiencing an unexpected 30–40 second delay when attempting to start a practice or sample test, caused by the test player incorrectly initiating a full-service worker installation and file download regardless of the tenant's offline delivery configuration. The fix ensures the service worker installation is now correctly driven by the tenant-level Offline Reliable Delivery setting, so students on tenants without this feature enabled can launch tests immediately without any unnecessary file download. (JIRA: INS-11979)

## Marking

- We fixed an issue in the Enrolment Based Marking Project workflow where transitioning a writing test attempt to "In Review" status caused all other test attempts within the enrolment to revert to "Marking" status, leaving candidate enrolments stuck in a "Partially Finalised" state even after marking was complete. The fix ensures that only the specific test attempt being transitioned to "In Review" is affected, allowing auto-marked tests to retain their completed status and enrolments to finalise correctly. (JIRA: INS-11347)
- We fixed an issue in the marking workflow where writing test attempts were not automatically transitioning to "Marked" status after all responses had been marked. The quick marking validation was incorrectly requiring a "marked on" timestamp for Instruction-type and Survey-type questions, which do not require marking and therefore never receive one. The system now correctly ignores unscorable question types (such as Instruction and Survey questions) during the quick marking transition check, allowing test attempts to move to "Marked" status once all markable responses have been completed. (JIRA: INS-11704)



- We have fixed an issue where users were able to click submit or review multiple times on the Quick Marking dashboard page. This was causing some answers to be duplicated in some cases. The Quick Marking page now stops the user from clicking a review or submission button more than once and will stop this from occurring in future events. (JIRA: INS-11775)
- We fixed an issue in Quick Marking where the Bulk Submit button on the Pending Review tab was throwing a 400 error and failing silently when attempting to submit AI-marked responses. The bulk submit logic was not correctly handling the AI answer score, preventing it from being copied over to the user answer score for submission. The system now correctly accepts the AI suggested score, copies it to the user answer score, and submits it as the final answer score, with the submitting user properly stamped on each answer record. (JIRA: INS-11805)

## Reporting

- We fixed a caching issue in the Guttman Report where switching to a Teacher role could result in the report filter displaying events from beyond the expected year range, and the side navigation showing menu items intended for super administrators rather than the restricted Teacher view. The issue occurred because cached UI state and filter data from the previous session or role were not being cleared when a user switched roles. The system now correctly refreshes role-specific UI state and filter data upon role switching, ensuring teachers see only the events and navigation items appropriate to their role. (JIRA: INS-11761)
- We fixed a discrepancy in the Guttman Report where score percentages shown in the online view did not match those in the exported Excel report, specifically affecting writing test results. The online report was calculating score percentages using a different method to the export, causing confusion for teachers comparing the two views. The system now ensures consistent



score percentage calculations across both the Guttman online report and its exported version.

(JIRA: INS-11835)

- We fixed an issue in the Guttman Report where correctly answered student responses were displaying an “Incorrect” annotation when previewed, even though the underlying scores were recorded accurately. The incorrect annotation appeared in both the Guttman Report preview and the Test Attempt preview page due to a mismatch between the displayed annotation and the actual scoring data. The system now correctly reflects the score result in the preview, ensuring that correctly answered responses are annotated accordingly. (JIRA: INS-11886)

## Improvements

### People

- We have added National Student Number (NSN) validation to the Student Import process. The system now validates that each student record in the import file contains an NSN that is present, exactly 10 characters in length, and composed entirely of numeric characters. If any student row has a missing, incorrectly formatted, or non-numeric NSN, the import is rejected with a validation error and no records are created or updated, ensuring that incomplete or invalid student data cannot be imported. (JIRA: INS-11030)

### Reporting

- We improved the Customisable Reports sharing behaviour so that when the “Me/Creator and Others” scope is selected, the report now defaults to being visible only to the report creator unless additional users are explicitly added. Previously, selecting this scope could inadvertently



expose a report to unintended users before any sharing configuration was completed. This change gives report creators greater control over visibility from the moment of creation. (JIRA: INS-11571)

## New Features

### Delivery

- We introduced a visible percentage (%) button to the calculator stationery tool in the Test Player, making the percentage operator directly accessible in the calculator interface. Previously, the % function was only accessible via the Shift+5 keyboard shortcut and had no corresponding button in the calculator UI. The new button behaves consistently with the existing calculator controls, includes accessibility support, and allows candidates to perform percentage calculations with a single click during assessments. (JIRA: INS-11771)
